Art Shop Philosophy

The Art Shop generates revenue for the Arts Council of the North Okanagan with most of the profit going back to the Vernon Community Arts Centre.

It is an opportunity for members of ACNO to sell high quality, hand produced artwork. We accept and promote the work of emerging and established artists based on a jurying process.

Evaluation Criteria: The jury panel will evaluate the work in these areas:

- Overall Impression & Sale Ability The suitability and potential for sale at VCAC.
- Concept & Originality The work is original and not derivative of other artists or work already sold at the Art Shop.
- Level of Achievement & Technical Skill- A body of work that reflects a style and approach to the medium as well as skill in the handling of the medium. Handling of the media exhibits control, skill, and experience.
- Quality of Materials & Product– Are the materials used of consistently good quality? Are the items consistent in quality?
- Presentation & Support Material The work itself is presented appropriately for display in the
 Art Shop. Wall pieces ready to hang, forms to display jewelry or other small or specialty items?
 Specialty support materials (sleeves, stands, mannequins) must be provided if required for
 presentation. They must be professional and appropriate for display in the Art Shop

Requirements for items accepted for sale

- The number of pieces accepted may be limited due to availability of space. In general, each artist is allotted approximately 1 cubic foot of space worth of work.
- Limited wall space means we can only accept 2 or 3 small (i.e. 4x6, 5x7, 6x6,) OR 1 larger (i.e 12x12, 11x14) prints or paintings at a time from each artist.
- Up to 25 single art cards can be accepted from each artist, and they must fit into the card rack.
- All work must be original and made by the submitting artist.
- The minimum price of works for sale in the Art Shop is \$5.00.
